Entrapment Rescue Training – industrial Machinery

For the most part, operators are trained in the safe use of industrial machinery and are prevented access to the danger areas while the machines are operational. A catastrophic failure of the machine, bypass of a guard or guarding device, or failure to adequately lock out machinery when necessary, may result in a person being trapped in the machine.

It is unlikely that police officers, firefighters, ambulance personnel, or anyone else that may arrive at the accident scene knows how the machine functions in order to release the trapped person quickly without causing additional harm to the victim. **Your employees need to be the in-house experts.**

This ½ day course is designed to teach participants the best methods of releasing a trapped person from a machine in an efficient way while keeping injuries to a minimum.
